

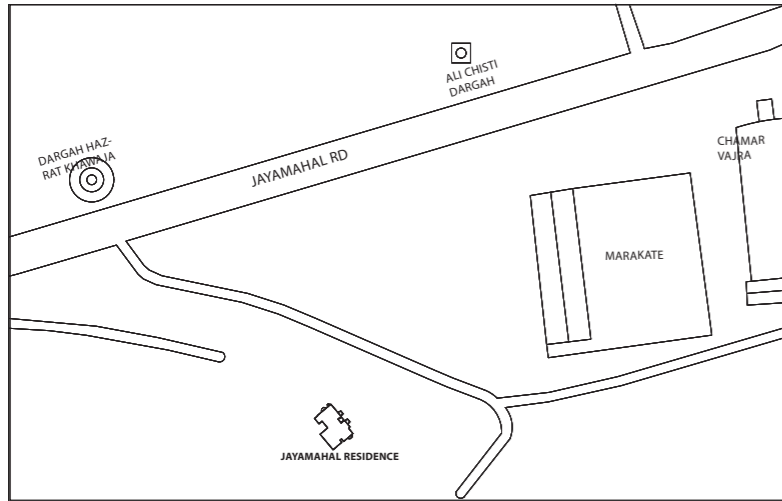


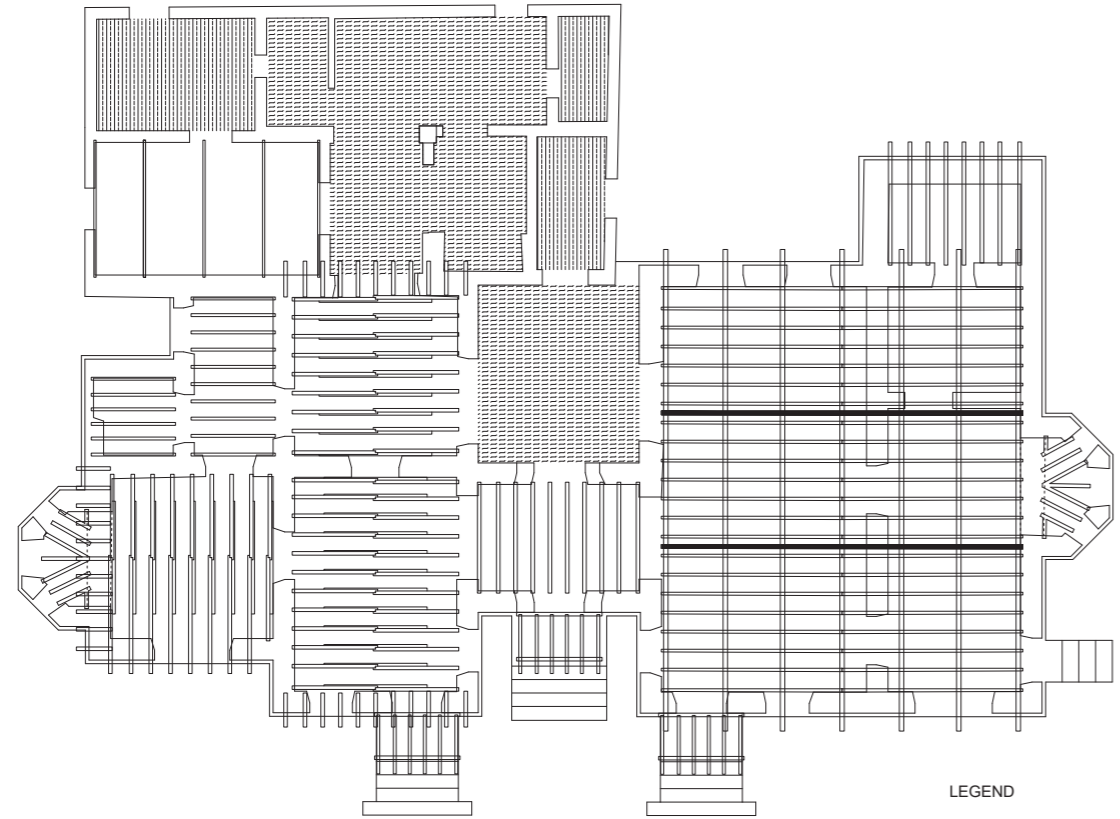

JAYAMAHAL: DRAWINGS AND DETAILS

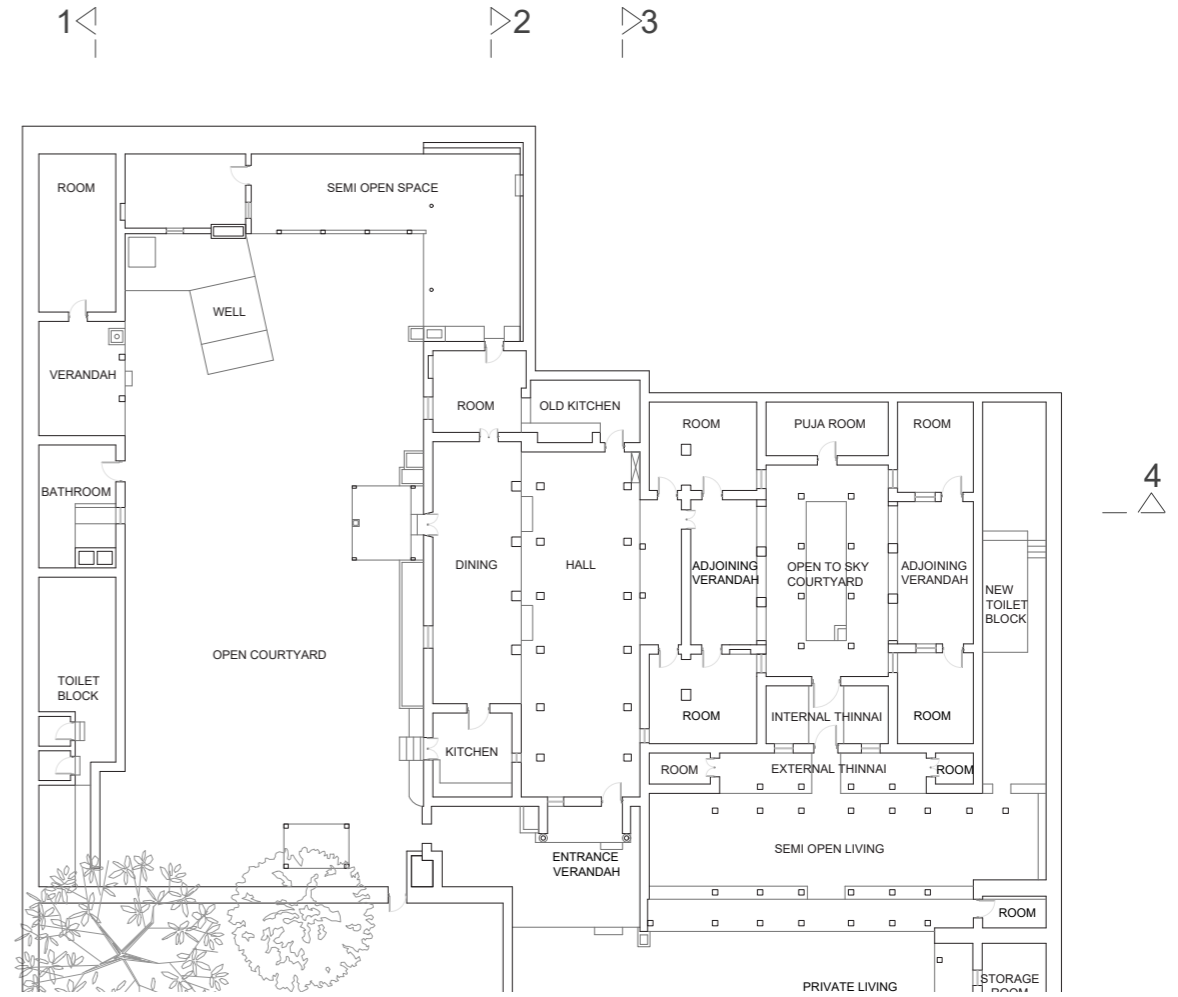
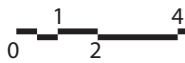
The project is situated in Bengaluru's ancillary lung space, specifically within the palace grounds, a prestigious wedding venue among the elite. The primary objective is restoring a century-old bungalow formerly owned by the Wadiyars. The design concept revolves around the adaptive reuse of the bungalow, transforming it into a wedding accommodation unit for the bride and groom during the wedding season and operating as an Airbnb throughout the rest of the year.

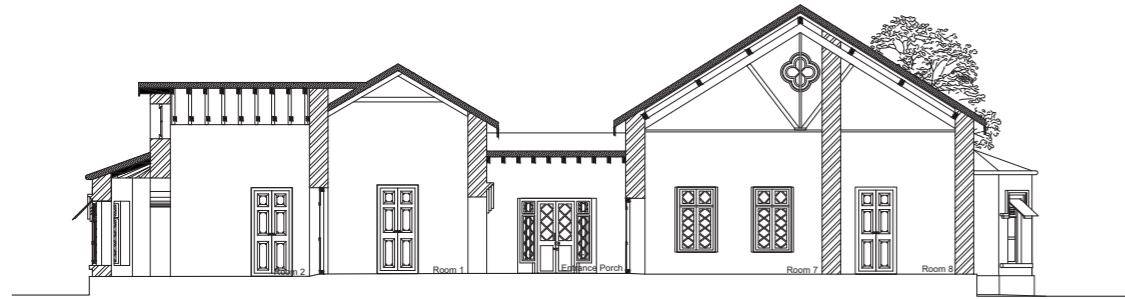

SIDE ELEVATION 01

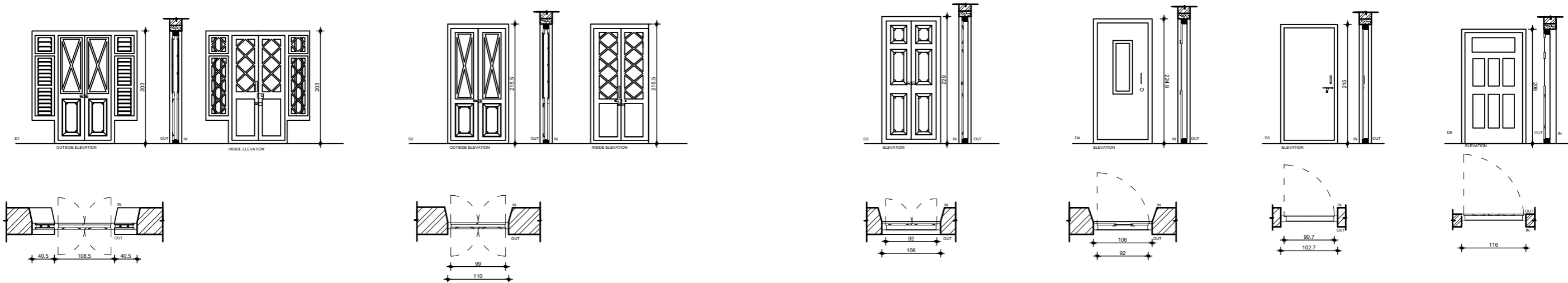


REAR ELEVATION

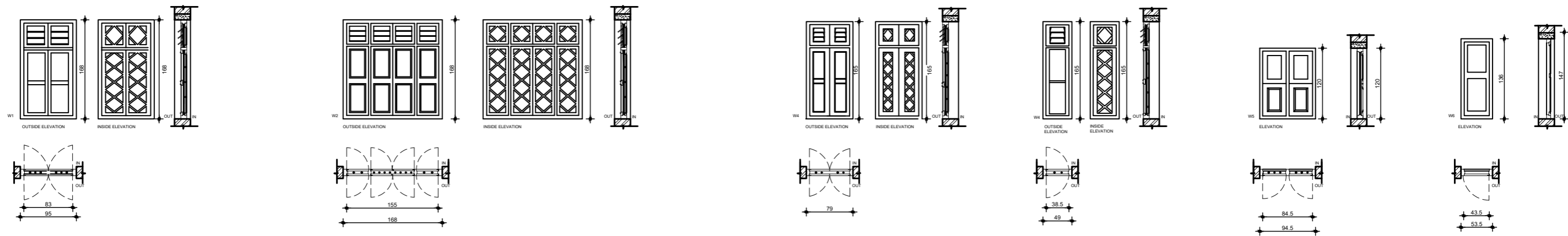
